...instructs Passover Prep....**Matthew 26:16-19**

...celebrates Passover.....**Matthew 26:20-25**

...sends Judas on his way....**Matthew 26:14-15**

On Friday Jesus...

...institutes Lord's Supper...**Matthew 26:25-29**

...gives farewell discourse...**Matthew 26:31-35**

...prays in the garden.....**Matthew 26:36-46**

...arrested in darkness.....**Matthew 26:47-56**

...abandoned by his disciples...**Matthew 26:56**

On Friday Jesus...

...examined by Annas, Caiaphas, Pilate, Herod ,
back to Pilate...**Matthew 26:57-68 & 27:1-26**

...denied by Peter.....**Matthew 26:69-75**

...hears the multitude cry for his crucifixion &
the release of Barnabas.....**Matthew 27:15-26**

...mocked, beaten, stripped by the soldiers, &
led to the cross.....**Matthew 27:27-31**

On Friday Jesus...

... is crucified between two thieves.....

.....**Matthew 27:32-38**

...is mocked by the chief priests, scribes & passers-by.....

Matthew 27:39-44

...dies on the cross, temple veil splits, graves open, & bodies rose.....

Matthew 27:45-56

...is prepared & buried.....

Matthew 27:57-61

Then Sunday Arrives and Jesus...

...raises from the dead & escapes
the sealed tomb... **Matthew 28:1-7**

Imagine the Great Joy
Matthew 28:8-10

Finally, Monday
