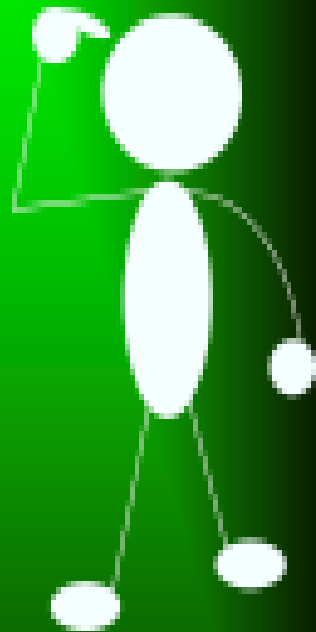

**Jesus Heals the Deaf Mute**

# Journey to the Sea, **Mark 7:31-37**

## ▲ **31**, Leaves Tyre/Sidon region

- Heals Syro-Phoenician woman's daughter
- A woman blessed for her faith, **Mark 7:24-30**

## ▲ **31**, Travels through region of Decapolis

- Primarily Gentile & Hellenistic cultures

## ▲ **Matthew 15:29-30**, Adds Details

- Jesus goes to a mountain and sits down
- Lame, blind, mute...laid at his feet...heals
- Multitude marveled & glorified God of Israel

# One Story Among Many

## ▲ 32, Deaf mute brought to Jesus

- Friends begged Jesus, put his hand on him

## ▲ 33-34, Jesus takes him aside

- Put his fingers in his ears
- Spit and touched his tongue
- Looked to heaven & said, “Be opened”

## ▲ 35, Healing...instantaneous!!!

- Ears opened...Hears immediately
- Begins speaking plainly



# Command & Response

▲ **36**, “he charged them, that they should tell no man: but the more he charged them, so much the more...published it.”

▲ **37**, They were, “astonished beyond measure, saying, ‘He has done all things well. He makes both the deaf to hear, and the mute to speak.’”



Detailed account of miracle unusual

# Regarding the Healing

▲ Jesus may have used sign language to speak to the deaf mute

□ Fingers in the ears---“ I will help you”

□ Touch of the tongue---“This as well”

□ Spits---His intention was to heal, as Saliva thought to have medicinal properties

□ Look to heaven---Help from above

□ The sigh---Sympathizing  
Jesus, felt sorrow

□ **Isaiah 53:4**, “*He has born our griefs and carried our sorrows...*”



# Regarding The Declaration

*“He has done all things well.”*

- ▲ They were amazed at His miracles, **Mark 7:37**
- ▲ They marveled and glorified the God of Israel, **Matthew 15:31**
- ▲ They were astonished at His teachings, **Mark 1:22; Mark 6:2**



All before His amazing death, burial, resurrection, and ascension

# “He has done all things well.”

▲ He has given us rest for our soul!

□ **Matthew 11:28-29**, “Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.”

▲ He has given us peace the world cannot!

□ **John 14:27**, “Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.”

# “He has done all things well.”

▲ He has given us a plan of salvation!

□ **Mark 16:16**, “He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.”

□ **Galatians 3:27**, “For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.”

▲ He has given you hope of eternal life!

□ **Titus 3:7**, “...being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.”

# If Not, Why Not?

▲ Could it be due to our lack of faith?

□ **Mark 6:5-6**, In His own country, “He could do no mighty work there, except that He laid His hands on a few sick people and healed them. He marveled because of their unbelief. Then He went about the villages teaching.”

▲ Could it be our heart is restricted?

□ **2 Corinthians 6:11-13**, “O Corinthians! We have spoken openly to you, our heart is wide open. You are not restricted by us, but you are restricted by your own affections.”

# God Has Asked....

- ▲ *“Is anything too hard for the Lord?”*,  
**Genesis 18:14**
- ▲ *“Has the Lord’s arm been shortened?”*,  
**Numbers 11:23**
- ▲ *“Is My hand shortened at all that it cannot redeem?”*, *“Or Have I no power to deliver?”*, **Isaiah 50:2**
- ▲ *“Is the Spirit of the Lord restricted?”*,  
**Micah 2:7**
