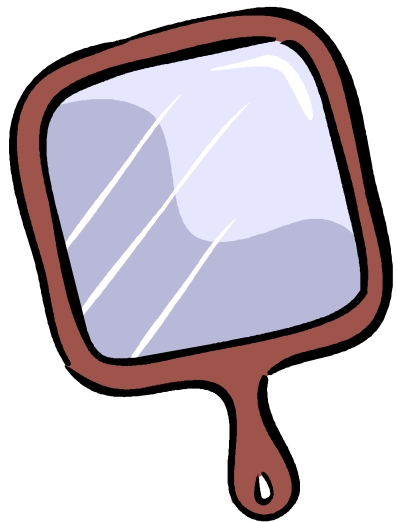

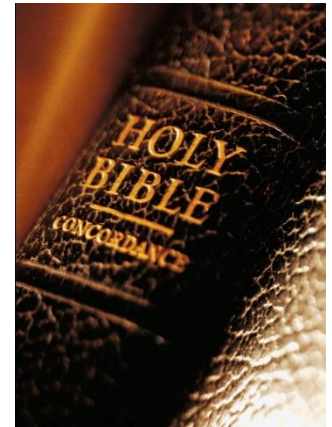


Isaiah 53:1-8



What Did Jesus Look Like?

- **History:** No record, No picture, No Idea
- **Gospel Writers:** No specific record
 - **Isaiah 53:1-2**, “...he hath no form nor comeliness (splendor); and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him.”
 - He was simple in appearance
 - His beauty was inward

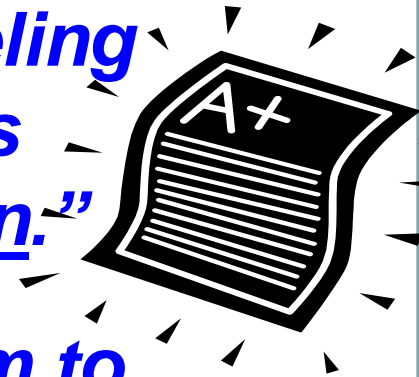


Question is:

How can we have this beauty in us?

Jesus Lived a Pure Life

- **Hebrews 4:15**, *"we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin."*
- **2 Corinthians 5:21**, *"he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him."*
- **Hebrews 5:8-9**, *"Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered; And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him"*

---By Being Pure

- Keeping Our Hearts Pure

- **Matthew 5:8**, "*Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God."*



- Keeping the “HOPE” alive

- **1 John 3:3**, “*every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure.”*

- Being an example to others

- **1st Timothy 4:12**, “*Let no man despise thy youth; but be thou an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity.”*



---By Abstaining From Impurities

- **1 Corinthians 3:16**, "Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?"
- **1 Peter 2:11**, "Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul"
- **1 John 1:5-7**, "God is light, and in him is no darkness at all. If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth: But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin."



---By Having Pure Speech

- **1 Peter 2:22**, "**Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth**"
- **1 Peter 2:1**, "**laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speakings**"
- **Proverbs 4:24**, "**Put away from thee a froward mouth, and perverse lips put far from thee.**"
- **Ephesians 4:29**, "**Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers.**"



---By Living Sacrificially

- **Philippians 2:5**, "Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross."
- **Matthew 16:25**, "If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me."



---By Living Sacrificially, cont.

- **Romans 12:1-2**, "*I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, & acceptable, & perfect, will of God.*"
- **Matthew 6:32-34**, "*...seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof.*"



---By Doing Good & Being Compassionate

- **Acts 10:38**, "God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good"
- **Matthew 15:32**, "Jesus called his disciples unto him, and said, I have compassion on the multitude"
- **Galatians 6:10**, "do good unto all men, especially unto them who are of the household of faith."
- **James 4:17**, "...to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin."



---By Doing Good & Being Compassionate cont.

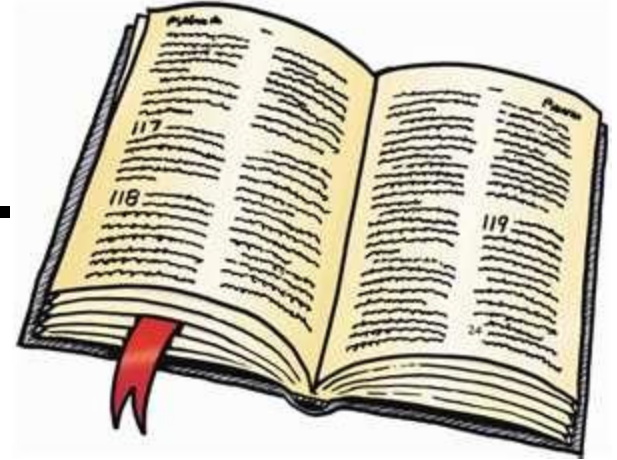
- **James 1:27**, “...visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world.”
- **James 2:15-16**, “If a brother or sister be naked, and destitute of daily food, And one of you say unto them, Depart in peace, be ye warmed and filled; notwithstanding ye give them not those things which are needful to the body; what doth it profit?”
- **Matthew 25:31-46**, Hungry, Thirsty, Stranger, Naked, Imprisoned
 - **Vs. 40**, “Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me.”



Conclusion of the Matter

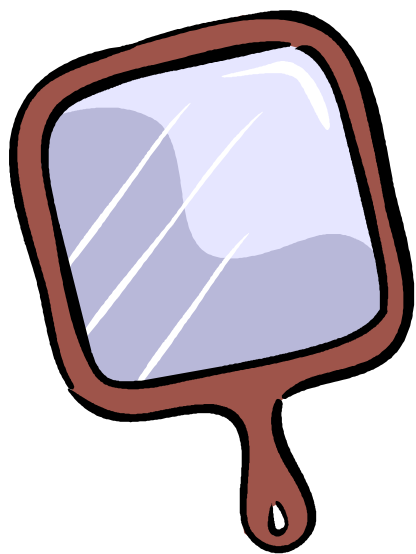
The beauty of Jesus is seen in me when...
