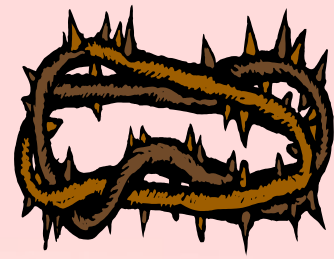


Remembering Jesus

1 Corinthians 11:23-29

Jesus' Sacrifice

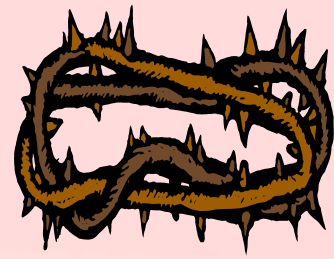
Isaiah 53:1-10



- **Death of suffering, shame, humiliation**
 - **Vs. 3**, *“despised and rejected of men”*
 - **Vs. 4**, *“borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows”*
 - **Vs. 5**, *“wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities”*
 - **Vs. 7**, *“brought as a lamb to the slaughter”*
 - **Vs. 8**, *“cut off of the land of the living”*
 - **Vs. 10**, *“it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he put him to grief...his soul an offering for sin”*

Jesus' Sacrifice

Philippians 2:6-10



- Death of suffering, shame, & humiliation
 - **Vs. 6**, *“being in the form God”*
 - **Vs. 7**, *“the form of a servant.... made in the likeness of men”*
 - **Vs. 8**, *“as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto...death of the cross.”*
 - **Vs. 9**, *“God...highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name”*
 - **Vs. 10**, *“at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth”*

Jesus' Sacrifice

Romans 5:6-9

- **Demonstration of God's love**

– *“when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet perhaps for a good man some would even dare to die. But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him.”*



How Do We Remember (Honor) His Sacrifice?

- Hear and understand God's plan
 - **Romans 10:17**, *“Faith cometh by hearing and hearing by the word of God”*
 - **Acts 17:11**, *“search the scriptures daily, whether those things are so”*
 - **1 Timothy 4:13**, *“give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine.”*
 - **2 Timothy 2:15**, *“study to show your self approved unto God...rightly dividing the word of truth”*
 - **1 Thessalonians 5:16**, *“Pray without ceasing”*



How Do We Remember (Honor) His Sacrifice?



- **Believe**, Jesus is God's Son
 - **John 8:24**, *“if ye believe not that I am he, ye shall die in your sins.”* (**John 14:6**)
- **Repent**, and turn from sins
 - **Acts 17:30**, *“the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent”* (**Luke 13:3**)
- **Confess** Jesus, God's Son before men
 - **Acts 8:37**, *“I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.”* (**Matthew 10:32-33**)

How Do We Remember (Honor) His Sacrifice?

- By being obedient, Baptism & Faithful

Romans 6:3-6, *“so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.”*



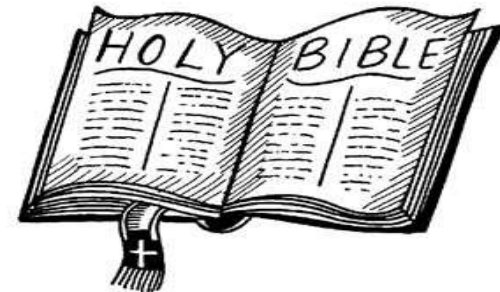
Revelation 2:10, *“be thou faithful unto death”*

How Do We Remember (Honor) His Sacrifice?

- **Worship in spirit & truth, John 4:24**
 - Teaching, **Acts 20:7**, *“Paul preached unto them... continued his speech until midnight”*
 - Praying, **1 Corinthians 14:15**, *“pray with the spirit...pray with the understanding”*
 - Singing, **1 Corinthians 14:15**, *“sing with the spirit... sing with the understanding”*
 - Giving, **1 Corinthians 16:2**, *“Upon the first day of the week let every one of you lay by him in store, as God hath prospered him”*
 - Communing, **Acts 20:7**, *“the first day of the week, when the disciples came together to break bread”*
(**1 Corinthians 11:24-26**)

Remember His Presence

- Jesus is always near
 - **Philippians 4:5**, “the Lord is at hand”
 - **Hebrews 13:5**, “he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.”
 - **Hebrews 4:14**, “we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our profession”
 - **1 Corinthians 10:16**, “The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ.”



Remember His Return

- He promised to come again

- **John 14:2-3**, *“I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.”*

- **1 Corinthians 11:26**, *“as often as ye eat this bread and drink this cup, ye do shew the Lord’s death till he come.”*



- He tells us to watch for Him

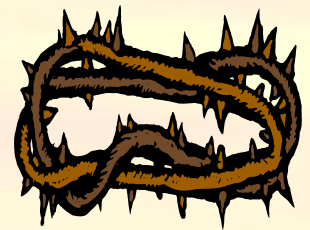
- **Matthew 25:13**, *“Watch therefore, for ye know neither the day nor the hour wherein the Son of man cometh.”*

Remember, When Jesus Comes...

- Men to be judged & destinies declared
 - **Matthew 25:31-45**, Sheep & Goats, Right & Left
 - **Matthew 25:46**, unrighteous to *“everlasting punishment...the righteous into life eternal.”*
- The faithful will love to see His coming
 - **2 Timothy 4:8**, *“there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing.”*
