# Cleopas & His Companion...

- **...Walked and talked**
  - **LUKE 24:13-14**, “two of them went that same day to a village called Emmaus, which was from Jerusalem about threescore furlongs. And they talked together of all these things which had happened.”
- **...Joined by Jesus, who sees their sadness**
  - **LUKE 24:15-17**, “What manner of communications are ...ye have one to another, as ye walk, and are sad?”
- **...Thought He was a stranger**
  - **LUKE 24:18**, “Cleopas, answering said unto him, Art thou only a stranger in Jerusalem, and hast not known the things which are come to pass there in these days?”

# They Taught the Stranger...

## • Things about Jesus of Nazareth, **VS. 19**

- **JOHN 1:45-46**, “Philip found Nathanael and said to him, “We have found Him of whom Moses in the law, and also the prophets, wrote--- Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph. Can there any good thing come out of Nazareth? Philip saith unto him, Come and see.”
- **HEBREWS 8:11-12**, “Know the Lord: for all shall know me, from the least to the greatest. For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more.”



# They Taught the Stranger...

- **Things** about Jesus the Prophet, **VS. 19**
  - **ACTS 3:22-23**, Peter quoting Moses, “A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your brethren, like unto me; him shall ye hear in all things whatsoever he shall say unto you. And it shall come to pass, that every soul, which will not hear that prophet, shall be destroyed from among the people.”
  - **HEBREWS 1:1-2**, “God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds”



# They Taught the Stranger...

- **Things about Jesus, mighty in deed, VS. 19**
  - **JOHN 20:30-31**, “many other signs truly did Jesus in the presence of his disciples, which are not written in this book: But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name.”
- **Things about Jesus, mighty in word, VS. 19**
  - **JOHN 7:45-46**, “Then the officers came to the chief priests and Pharisees, them, “Why have you not brought Him?” The officers answered, “No man ever spake like this Man!”

# They Taught the Stranger...

- **Things about the religious leaders who condemned Jesus to death, VS. 20**
  - **LUKE 24:20**, “chief priests and rulers delivered him to be condemned to death, and have him crucified.”
  - **JOHN 19:6**, “the chief priests and officers saw him, they cried out, saying, Crucify him, crucify him.”
- **Things about Jesus being crucified, VS. 20**
  - **MARK 15:19-20**, “smote him...spit upon him ...mocked him...led him to be crucified”
  - **MARK 15:25**, Third hour...“they crucified him.”
  - **MARK 15:34 & 37**, Ninth hour...He “cried with a loud voice, and gave up the ghost”
